

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Pier

John Eboli, 1600 W Lake St, Streamwood, IL, 60107, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to Piers, docks and wharves. The project is located in SE 1/4, NE 1/4, Section 35, Township 02N, Range 17E in City of Lake Geneva, Walworth County.

The proposed project is to place a new pier and slip and canopy with boat lift canopy for Bob Loquercio at 1310 W Main ST Lake Geneva, WI 53147 (tax key # (ZYUP 00094N) with 7 rock filled wood cribs on the lake bed of Geneva lake with a total crib surface area of 511 square feet. This will replace old pier to be removed upland. All materials will be brought in by barge. The slip and canopy is 14' wide and 32' long with slip finger and cross walk 6' wide. Load platform is 198 square feet (11'x18') and will be at the end of the main pier that is also 6' wide and the total length is 99'.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12 , 30.208, 281.36, Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity.

If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.


If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
